NASF Membership Categories



Corporate

Job Shop

This membership category applies to businesses whose primary operations are in surface finishing. Job Shops with a Chapter in their area must become members through their local organization. Job Shops without a local Chapter can become at-large members by applying online.

Suppliers, Consultants and Distributors

This membership category applies to companies engaged in the manufacture, sale and/ or development of equipment, materials or processes used in surface finishing. Supplier dues are based on annual sales revenue directly associated with surface finishing.

Associates, Captives and OEM

This membership category applies to businesses such as captive shops or OEMs that operate a surface finishing operation within their corporation that is not their sole source of revenue. 


